

Operating rules of the outdoor student coworking center at the Jarov Campus

1. Purpose and Use

- The coworking center is intended exclusively for study purposes and project work.
- Smoking, alcohol consumption and partying are prohibited in the coworking center.
- Sleeping overnight in the coworking center is prohibited.

2. Opening hours

- The coworking center is allowed to be used daily from 6:00 to 22:00.

3. Behavior and safety

- Users are obliged to maintain cleanliness and order.
- Users are obliged to adhere to the principles of good behavior and correct interpersonal relations and respect other users.
- Loud conversations and disruptive behavior are not allowed.
- Any damage to the equipment must be reported immediately to the University Hotel reception.

- The coworking center is under constant camera surveillance.

4. Facilities and services

- The coworking center offers high-speed internet on the eduroam network.
- Electricity is not available.

5. Sanctions

- Violation of the rules may lead to a temporary or permanent ban on entry to the coworking center.
- For pollution or damage to the coworking center, compensation will be charged according to the compensation price list.
