Rules for accommodation in dormitories FMD VSE in Prague (hereafter „FMD“)

In connection with the ongoing Covid 19 disease and in accordance with the "Set of recommendations for schools and school facilities in the school year 2021/2022, operation and testing", I order the following starting on 19 February 2022 from 00:00:

1) Entry to the dormitories of the University of Economics in Prague, either for accommodation or during accommodation, is allowed to persons who have stayed for more than 12 hours in the last 14 days in the territory of countries that are on the list of countries at risk of COVID-19 under the conditions defined by the Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic. (The list of countries according to the risks of the disease and the conditions of arrival from abroad to the Czech Republic will be listed on the SÚZ website.)

For this purpose, premises will be set up within the VŠE dormitories where these persons can spend the mandatory self-isolation. The capacity of these spaces is limited and everyone who wants to spend self-isolation in the VSE dormitories must book this bed by e-mail with the head of the dormitory and wait for confirmation. FMD reserves the right to order self-isolation for those accommodated who arrive from countries with a high risk of infection or very high risk of infection until they are proven with a negative test for SARS-CoV-2.

This does not apply to persons who prove themselves in the Czech Republic with a recognized vaccination certificate.

2) All accommodated persons in VSE dormitories are obliged to regularly monitor the FMD website where current information on the conditions of accommodation in VSE dormitories will be published.

3) All accommodated persons at the VSE dormitories are obliged at the request of an FMD employee to undergo non-contact body temperature measurement.

4) All persons who show symptoms of COVID-19, ie especially fever, cough, shortness of breath, indigestion, loss of smell, general weakness, or other symptoms, are strictly forbidden to enter the VSE dormitory. If necessary, these persons will be placed in designated quarantine rooms at the VSE dormitories. However, the capacities of these quarantine rooms are limited and in the event of their exhaustion, residents with symptoms of COVID-19 or a positive SARS-CoV-2 test will be obliged to spend quarantine outside the VSE dormitory facilities.

5) The movement of all persons in the common areas of the dormitories is only possible with a respirator or nano face mask fitted that meets the required parameters. Nose and mouth

must always be covered! This does not apply to persons who cannot wear respiratory protective equipment for serious health reasons and are able to prove this by a medical certificate.

6) All those accommodated persons in the VSE dormitories, ie students, doctoral students and tenants of flats, are obliged to use hand disinfection, especially before touching frequently used objects (especially handles, railings,...). Furthermore, they are strictly obliged to follow the rules for cleaning rooms and cells set by the Dormitory Rules and to ventilate the rooms regularly several times a day.

7) Only persons who are authorized to stay in the given dormitory are allowed to enter the common areas (kitchens, gyms, study rooms, games rooms,...). They are always obliged to use hand disinfection and to disinfect all areas they will touch on arrival and to disinfect all areas they have touched during their stay on the premises. It is not allowed to use common areas when accommodated in another dormitory.

8) Visits of third parties to the VSE dormitories are strictly prohibited both within student and PhD. students accommodation.

9) FMD reserves the right to charge for stay in isolation or quarantine in the amount of CZK 400/night. From this amount will be deducted the price of accommodation which the guest pays for a regular bed.

10) Accommodated persons can request disinfection of rooms and cells by ozonation from the dormitory staff.

Failure to comply with the principles set out in points 1) to 8) of this Director's Order will be considered a gross violation of the General Accommodation Conditions pursuant to Article VI. paragraph 1 (c) and in accordance with Article VI. paragraph 2, point III.

This order of the director takes effect on February 18, 2022.
