

OPERATING RULES AND REGULATIONS  
for climbing a bouldering facility in the area of Jarov dormitory of the University of Economics in  
Prague (VŠE v Praze)

Operating hours: from 8:00 AM till 10:00 PM

Operating rules and regulations are available at the Jarov III G dormitory reception, and also in an electronic version on SÚZ VŠE website (<https://suz.vse.cz/koleje/sportoviste/sportoviste/>).

The bouldering facility in the sporting area of Jarov dormitory may be used under the operating rules and regulations only by:

- Persons accommodated in VŠE dormitories, including hotel guests,
- VŠE students,
- VŠE employees,
- Guests of the persons listed above.

In case of a check, all users of the bouldering facility must identify themselves to a guard or SÚZ VŠE employee showing their dormitory card, VŠE student card, ISIC or a card of VŠE employee. The hotel guests shall report their name, surname, room number and the building they are accommodated in. At the same time they shall identify their guests they invited.

The operator provides for reservation of the bouldering facility against payment. Reservation may be done in the ISKAM system. Users who have made the paid reservation in the ISKAM system enjoy the exclusive right to make use of the bouldering facility for themselves and their guests in the reserved time. Other people interested in using the bouldering facility may the right to use it freely in the periods not booked through the paid reservation.

**Principal provisions:**

All users of the bouldering facility are obliged to get acquainted with the operational rules and regulations for climbing the bouldering facility and to obey to all their provisions.

All the users of the bouldering facility **take note of the fact that they do climbing at their own risk, and confirm that they realize all risks associated with such activity.**

When bouldering/climbing, the user is obliged to follow all safety and caution principles. Especially he/she is obliged to behave in a way not limiting or endangering other users.

**Namely, the following rules apply to all the users:**

- a) They must observe all principles of safety bouldering/climbing.
- b) They must use only special climbing shoes.
- c) The use of magnesium/chalk is allowed,
- d) Before starting climbing, all things must be taken-off from the cash pad area under a route.
- e) The bouldering facility should be used exclusively for training of climbing without a rope.
- f) For leaps, there is a fall area made of a fine pebble; for leaps from a higher rise, it is recommended to use a bouldering mat.
- g) When climbing and jumping down, always check a free space so that you do not endanger yourself or the others.
- h) Due to safety and static reasons, the maximum number of boulderers using the boulder at the same time is determined as 5 persons.
- i) When bouldering/climbing difficult routes, the boulderers are obliged to climb in pairs in order to provide each other support as it is usual in outdoor bouldering/climbing natural boulders.
- j) Other persons are not allowed to be under the climbers except the one who provides the support.

- k) To leave/to descend from the boulder use easier routes.
- l) You must warn users breaching the provisions of these operational rules and regulation about that fact, and if no redress takes place, you must inform the responsible person.
- m) You must inform the responsible person of any technical defect found (e.g. a loose hold). Information of technical defects should be conveyed immediately in the time from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM to the phone number 734 265 800. **The users are not allowed:**

- a) to climb under the effect of alcohol or drugs,
- b) to smoke in the area of the bouldering facility,
- c) to bring into the area of the bouldering facility any glass or food,
- d) to stay in the space under the boulder if not climbing/bouldering it,
- e) to modify the routes or boulder in any way,
- f) to soil or pollute surroundings of the boulder; a sanitary facility in the ground floor of the CKJ building should be used.

**Consequences of breaching these rules and regulations:**

1. The operator and its responsible person may order the user breaching these rules and regulation out of the bouldering facility.
2. A fine up to CZK 500 may be charged for a serious violation of these rules and regulations.

**The operator bears no liability caused by a boulderer to himself/herself or any other people when bouldering or staying in the area of the bouldering facility. The user is liable for any and all activities (climbing and/or any other kind of activity) performed in the dormitory sport facilities.**

**In case of injury call the rescue service 155.**

The boulderers may borrow the bouldering mat from the Jarov III G dormitory reception against a returnable deposit of CZK 1000 (information may be obtained at phone number 224 092 128).

The operator is entitled to modify or adjust the provisions of the operational rules and regulations.
