Quarantine rules

In connection with the current development of coronavirus infection worldwide and in the Czech Republic, measures issued by the Ministry of Health and to update the orders of the head of the DAF VŠE No. 4/2020 and 5/2020 with immediate effect

issue this order of the director of DAF VŠE:

1. Mandatory quarantine.

All persons who have been in China, Hong Kong, Iran, Japan, Singapore, South Korea, or Italy in the last 14 days have been mandated a two-week quarantine for violating the Public Health Protection Act up to three million czech crowns. These persons are obliged to contact their doctor by telephone or written form. Upon arrival at the dormitories of the University of Economics, these persons are obliged to follow the order of the director No. 5/2020.

2. Recommended quarantine.

People returning from all risk areas around the world:

are obliged to report the above mentioned facts at the reception of the dormitory of the University of Economics, to which they are staying and to fill out a short questionnaire, here. After evaluating this questionnaire and thus the level of risk of infection, a 14-day quarantine can be ordered, which they will spend:

- a) especially in your home (i.e. not at the VŠE dormitory);
- b) only in necessary and justified cases in a specially reserved quarantine cell at the Blanice dormitory or other dormitories.

If they are allowed to stay in the dormitory, they may be ordered to do another measures (regular temperature measurement, relocation, etc.)

Attention, this is a change - update the Director's Order No. 5/2020!!!

3. Rules of home quarantine.

If possible, set aside a separate room and isolate yourself from other household members. Use a face mask or keep yourself away from members of your household more than one meter away, avoid physical touch, use disinfectants, and follow personal hygiene practices, especially hand washing.

Persons in home quarantine are required to monitor their health status, including regular temperature measurement, if they develop established clinical symptoms of the disease (dyspnoea, cough, fever and joint pain), they must notify their doctor and public health authorities.

If there is a possibility not to go shopping, but if necessary, then always with a face mask and not to walk among the larger group of people, keep them as far as possible. Wash or disinfect hands carefully before leaving and after arrival.

4. Quarantine rules at the VŠE dormitories.

At the VŠE dormitories (especially at the Blanice dormitory) there are spaces reserved for persons who, for serious reasons, cannot spend quarantine time in their home environment. As in the case of home quarantine, it is necessary to observe all hygiene measures. This means using a face mask, to keep other people no closer than one meter, avoiding physical contact, disinfecting and observing personal hygiene practices, especially hand washing. These persons are forbidden to enter the common areas of the dormitory (eg study room, gym, cafeteria, canteen, etc.). They cannot visit and cannot accept any visits. Persons in quarantine are required to monitor their medical condition, including regular temperature measurements, if they develop clinical symptoms of the disease (dyspnoea, cough, fever and joint pain), they must report this (not personally!) to the dormitory management, their doctor and authorities of public health.

They will discuss with the dormitory management the possibility of securing the necessary shopping and catering. If possible, not to go shopping, but if necessary, always with a face mask and not to walk among the larger group of people, keep them as far as possible. Wash or disinfect hands carefully before leaving and after arrival. Always use a separate entrance for the Blanice dormitory.

5. Ban on visits to the dormitories.

For all accommodated at the dormitories of the University of Economics, I declare prohibition from receiving visits of any person not living on the same dormitory. In connection with this, reception of individual dormitories is obliged to significantly increase the intensity of checks of persons entering the dormitory.

6. Disinfection.

Beginning March 10th, 2020, disinfection of the common dormitory areas will be carried out regularly (according to the possibilities of the supplier company).

7. Temperature measurement.

Contactless thermometers are available at all dormitory receptions. In the interest of all residents, it is recommended that they regularly measure the temperature every day, in case of emerging symptoms of illness it is a necessity.

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
