Order of the Director of SÚZ VŠE in Prague No. 3/2022

Measures in the field of energy saving and fire protection on VŠE dormitories

In line with the global trend of reducing energy consumption, in regards of rising energy prices and environmental protection, and in an effort to minimize dormitory price increases, I issue the following order to the Director:

- 1) All accommodated students in VŠE dormitories are obliged to:
 - a. Respect the temperature limits in the dormitory common areas. In study rooms at approx.20 ° C, in gyms, laundries, communal kitchens at approx.15 ° C.
 - b. If they leave the room and this one will be empty for more than a day, turn off the heating.
 - c. In the heating season, ventilate the rooms with intensive but time-limited ventilation only for the necessary time. It is forbidden to ventilate rooms with window ventilation with the heating on.
 - d. When not present in common areas of the cell (hall, kitchen) turn off all lights and all electrical appliances, except refrigerators, especially cookers and similar heat appliances.
 - e. When leaving the room, switch off or, in the case of appliances without a switch, unplug all electrical appliances (especially switch off the lights, unplug the empty charger or computer).
 - f. Strictly comply with Article IV., Point 1. I. letter k) of the GTC, ie notify the head of the relevant track in advance of the use of their own certified electrical appliances. This regulation also applies to the use of computer technology (laptops, desktops, monitors, printers,...) with a total power consumption of more than 500 W.
 - g. Use computer technology on dormitories exclusively for study and educational purposes. In particular, it is strictly forbidden to use computer technology to extract cryptocurrencies, it is forbidden to use special powerful computer technology (specialized gaming computers with a power input of over 500 W) to play games. It is forbidden to leave computers running unattended to perform tasks other than those related to teaching and learning.
- 2) SÚZ VŠE v Praze will consider the violation of the above rules as a gross violation of the accommodation contract and will charge them compensation for the electric or thermal energy consumed by the accommodated persons in violation of this order of the director in the amount corresponding to SÚZ's additional costs.

This order of the director takes effect on 01. 02. 2022.
